




SEDONA, ARIZONA; ELPORTALSEDONA.COM (from \$299/night)




#### HILTON MILWAUKEE CITY CENTER

Also create a list of animal hospitals along your travel route and at your final destination. If any emergency occurs, you won't have to waste time researching.

### $\#_b$ BOWLS

Hunter uses a collapsible bowl for her trips, but feel free to bring your regular bowls or dog-friendly water bottles.



#### **EXTRA FOOD**

"Have plenty of what they're used to. Bring more than what you're used to," Hunter said. If your dog is prone to

carsickness, feed him when you arrive at your destination and not before or during travel breaks.

Canine guests can expect a dog bed (every bit as welcoming as their human's), food and water bowls, treats and a stylish bandana. Plus, there's plenty to explore with the Magnificent Mile, Navy Pier and Lakefront Trail at your doorstep.
